

## WAC MEETINGS AND DUES

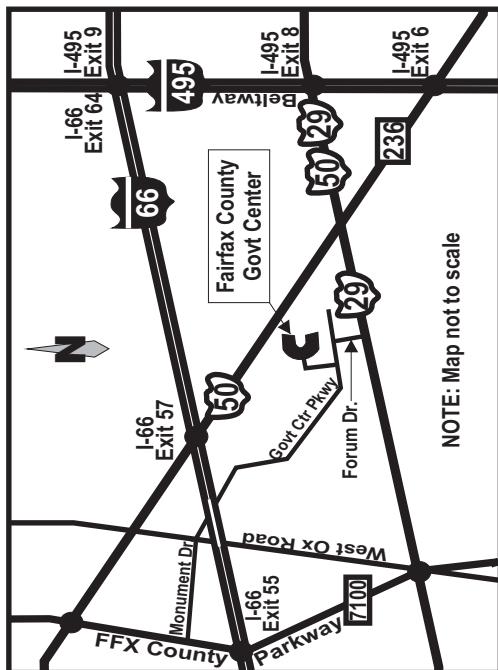
